

<u>Reconstruction Design Contest Explanation and Student Template</u>

Do you like art, often draw or paint, or just want to win some extra money? Then the Reconstruction Design Contest is for you!

Reconstruction is a company dedicated to unapologetically Black education. We're not like regular school. Reconstruction is different - we want to make learning and education fun. We want you to learn about things that interest you. There are no tests and no pressure. We want you to feel empowered and loved in our classes. And we want to uplift all the amazing contributions of Black people in our world!

This contest will equip students to get further involved with Reconstruction by submitting a logo design. The three students (one elementary, middle, and high) with the chosen designs by our committee will win a \$500 prize and be celebrated by the Reconstruction Community.

Students, submit your design to us using this <u>Google Form</u> by April 1st. After submission, you'll receive a response email letting you know we received your submission. Winners will be chosen and announced on April 15th World Art Day and you'll receive your prize by April 17th. To be eligible to enter the Contest, entries must either be submitted by persons age 14 and older or have obtained prior permission from an authorized adult. Contest is void where prohibited by law.

We are looking for a design which celebrates Black History all year by using the Black Power Fist. What does Black History mean to you? What changes do you want to see in your community or school? Draw a fist that represents that. If you would rather create your design digitally on the computer, you can do that as well. Look at the design templates below to spark some ideas and inspiration.
